 - Providing and updating information sources, work instructions and supervision levels for employees
 - Providing and maintaining safe plant, tools and equipment
2. Regular consultation with employees on matters specifically affecting health and safety
3. It is pro-active in the prevention of work place accidents and work related ill health
4. It has an ongoing review process and carries out updates to the Company
